**STILL WATERS SINGLE MALT VODKA WINS BRONZE  
AT SAN FRANCISCO WORLD SPIRITS COMPETITION**

**Concord, Ontario, March 29, 2010** - Still Waters Single Malt Vodka, from Ontario's first and only grain-to-glass micro-distillery, has won a bronze medal at the prestigious 2010 San Francisco World Spirits Competition.

The San Francisco World Spirits Competition is the most influential and respected spirits competition in the world. Celebrating its 10th year, the 2010 Competition was the biggest in its history. 30 judges gathered at the Hotel Nikko in downtown San Francisco on March 13 and 14 to reward spirits excellence by evaluating 1024 different spirits from 57 countries. These judging panels were comprised of spirits experts from noted restaurants and hotels, well-known spirits journalists from major national media, spirits buyers for large purveyors, and spirits consultants. Judging was based on a blind, consensual procedure, ensuring competitive integrity as it remains the most recognized competition in the spirits industry.

The Still Waters Distillery is Ontario's first and only craft distillery. Their Single Malt Vodka is made from 100% Canadian two-row malted barley. It is made by hand in small batches in a traditional pot still using artisanal distilling techniques. Though produced locally in Ontario, most of their sales are outside of the province.

"We are pleased that our first product has attracted international attention", says Barry Bernstein, co-founder of Still Waters Distillery. "We have received many local accolades but international recognition lets us play on the world stage" says Barry Stein, the other co-founder and partner in the business. The partners have developed their unusual but exceptional Single Malt Vodka through careful research and experimentation and are proud of the craftsmanship used to produce each and every bottle.
